How it Works

- ▶ Mentoring colleagues/members in volunteering management

Get Started

1. Apply online at www.volunteeringvictoria.org.au/CPD
2. Read the FAQs and CPD Activity Point Schedule to plan your CPD activities for the year - you must achieve minimum 16 points.
3. Participate in your chosen CPD activities and complete the Activity Validation Form after each activity
4. Update your activity validation form to VV every two months or at the end of December 2020.
5. Achieve 16 CPD points by the end of the year and receive your formal certificate and option to use **PLV** after your name.
