## How it Works

- ▶ Mentoring colleagues/members in volunteering management

## Get Started

2. Read the FAQs and CPD Activity Point Schedule to plan your CPD activities for the year - you must achieve minimum 16 points.
3. Participate in your chosen CPD activities
4. Log your points after each activity or by the end of December 2022.
5. Achieve 16 CPD points by the end of the year and receive your formal certificate and option to use **PLV** after your name.
